The Lodge

Location

The lodge (often referred to just as “AAC” or sometimes “the Huetten” – German for “hut”) is sited on the edge of the Village ski bowl, near the base of the Eagle and Summit chairlifts. It is also a short walk to the nightlife and local restaurants.

Facilities

The lodge has twelve bedrooms, each consisting of a combination of double bed and double plus single bed layouts, all with ensuite bathrooms. There are also three bunkrooms, which sleep four, five or six people.

A large living/dining area with a mezzanine lounge and fireplace provide a pleasant and relaxing après ski environment. There is a TV/video room, a games room with table soccer, table tennis and snooker table, an indoor spa and sauna. Laundry facilities are also provided.

Services

A full-time lodge manager is employed to ensure that members and guests are welcomed to the lodge. The lodge is open all year.

Winter tariffs are excellent value and include a cooked breakfast served every morning. A modern well-equipped kitchen is available for the preparation of lunch and dinner.

Linen is provided during the ski season, beds are made for arrival of guests and rooms are cleaned upon departure.

Members of Australian Alpine Club Falls Creek also enjoy reciprocal booking rights at other Australian Alpine Club lodges at Dinner Plain, Mt Buller (Collegians), Mt Hotham (Anton) and Perisher. The Australian Alpine Club is also establishing a lodge in Niseko, Japan.

Arrangements also exist for lodge accommodation at Perisher, Thredbo and Charlotte Pass through our links with the Southern Alps Ski Club. Australian Alpine Club members are also welcome at the Christiania Ski Club at Mt Ruapehu in New Zealand.

How to join

Adult membership of Australian Alpine Club Falls Creek consists of a joining fee and a refundable debenture. The debentures are valued at \$2,000 and the joining fee is \$2,200; payments can be made in two annual instalments. There is a 20% discount on the joining fee if membership is purchased in one instalment (i.e. \$3,760).

Adult membership subscriptions are less than \$300, payable in January each year; with accommodation discount vouchers worth \$50 awarded for prompt payment.

Try before you buy

Guests at Australian Alpine Club Falls Creek who decide to join within twelve months of their stay will be refunded the difference between the guest accommodation rate and the member accommodation rate.
